2.0 Description of Works:

For getting the Letter of Intent (LOI) for the purpose of granting mining lease of limestone mineral in favor of M/s Gujarat Industries Power Company Limited from Industries and Mines Department, Government of Gujarat.

Gujarat Industries Power Company Limited (GIPCL) was incorporated in the year 1985 as a Public Limited Company. The Company is registered with the Registrar of Companies, Gujarat under the Companies Act, 1956, registered and corporate Office is located at P.O. Ranoli, Vadodara- 391 350, Gujarat, India. GIPCL has been promoted by Gujarat Fertilizers and Chemicals Ltd. (GSFC), Gujarat Alkalies and Chemicals Ltd. (GACL) and Gujarat Urja Vikas Nigam Ltd.(GUVNL, erstwhile Gujarat Electricity Board). GIPCL functions under the umbrella of Energy and Petrochemicals Department, Govt. of Gujarat. GIPCL's equity shares are listed on the Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE) and National Stock Exchange (NSE).

GIPCL is in the business of Electrical Power Generation, the current installed capacity is 1184.4MW. The Company has a diversified power generation portfolio comprising Thermal (Lignite and Gas) and Renewable (Wind and Solar) Power Plants. GIPCL also operates captive Lignite and Limestone Mines to meet the fuel requirement of the 500 MW Surat Lignite Power Plant. Over the years, GIPCL has established itself as a formidable player in the power generation business.

7.1 Bidder or his expert (Team Member) should possess minimum one year of experience during last five years ending last day of the month previous to the one in which tender is invited in similar nature of jobs like Providing Consultancy/ Advisory Services for obtaining of any Major Mineral Mine leases in Gujarat during the last five years / Consultant possesses experience in making an application of Mineral Lease at State Level and Ministry of Mines, Delhi and should enclose proof of the same. Bidder shall submit necessary evidence for the same like self attested copies of work orders/Work Execution/ work completion certificates from clients.

All specified work executed by the bidders, both directly and as a sub contractor shall be taken into consideration.

7.2 Bidder should produce evidence of having experience of successfully completed similar works as defined hereunder for during last five years ending last day of the month previous to the one in which tender is invited, satisfactory progress of ongoing works etc. secured from clients along with self attested copies of documentary evidence preferably photo copies of work experience. The experience should be either of the following:

Three similar completed/executed works each costing not less than the amount equal to Rs. 8.00 Lakhs.

Bidder should specifically mention fulfilling of above criteria in his offer along with details of work orders & work completion/execution certificates issued by clients.

In case EMD is paid in the form of BG, the same shall be valid for a period of 120 days after the due date for submission of the bid. The EMD of the successful bidder will be returned after submission of Security Deposit/PBG by successful bidder within 7 days from the date of award of contract by way of issue of LOI (Letter of Intent) or Work Order, whichever is earlier.

The earnest money deposit will be refunded to the unsuccessful Bidder after the tender is finalized and after award of LOI/WO.

Any bid not accompanied with EMD and Tender fee will be rejected. Tender fees and EMD shall be submitted to GIPCL. No interest shall be payable on EMD.

- 7.5 Attested copies of relevant documents duly signed & seal on each & every page shall be submitted. GIPCL may verify the documents, experience certificates issued by concern authority. After opening of technical Bid, if any required attested documents found missing in the Technical Bid submitted by the Bidder, the tender inviting authority may inform to that Bidder by E-mail to submit the missing required documents within stipulated time limit. If Bidder/Bidders fail to submit within stipulated time, their Bid will be declared technically disqualified and no further correspondence will be entertained.
- 7.6 Bidder should have average annual turnover of Rs. 06.00 Lakhs during last three financial years i.e. 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23. Bidder shall furnish annual audited financial statement duly certified by Chartered Accountant for the said last three financial years to demonstrate the financial healthiness of the company. The balance Sheet and Profit and Loss Account must be in the name of the company. Any type of MOU for this purpose will not be entertained. Where audit is not applicable to the bidder as per applicable laws of the land, due certification by a qualified Chartered Accountant who should be a member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India of the said turnover for the said last three financial years will have to be done & furnished.
- **7.7** The Bidder has to submit INCOME TAX Permanent Account Number (PAN) & GST registration number. Copies of the same shall be submitted.
- 7.8 If Bidder or its Partner(s) or Director(s) is /are/was Black Listed / Deregistered/ Stopped or banned from dealing in the past by any Govt of Gujarat Undertakings / Depts./ Authorities and Govt. of Gujarat supported companies /Undertakings / Organizations, Bid of that party may be liable to be rejected. Bidder agrees and undertakes to accept decision of GIPCL in this regards as final and binding on the Bidder without any demur and that no further correspondence shall be done in this regard at any stage. Bidder shall have to submit "Declaration for Contractual Litigations" as amended in Forms attached.
- **7.9** Bidder shall have to submit the "Declaration-cum-Undertaking for Compliance of Safety Laws and Regulations" as amended in Forms attached.

If any Major Violation of any safety Law(s) / Rule(s) is / are found during the

preceding Three (3) years i.e. 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23, bid of that party will be liable to be rejected. Bidder agrees and undertakes to accept decision of GIPCL in this regards as final and binding on the Bidder without any demur and that no further correspondence shall be done in this regard at any stage.

If any of the details submitted in the prescribed Forms to the Bid is/are found to be false, incorrect at any time in future, then the Contract awarded to that Bidder/ Contractor shall be liable to be terminated forthwith without any notice / correspondence and Bidder agrees and undertakes to accept decision of GIPCL in this regards as final and binding on the Bidder without any demur and that no further correspondence shall be done in this regard at any stage. Further, Performance Security Deposit will also be liable to be forfeited. Any dues to GIPCL from the Bidder / Contractor shall be recovered from the pending bills or any other dues payable to the Bidder / Contractor, if any or otherwise through any other recourse available under the Laws.

8.0 EVALUATION OF BIDS

- a) Price Bid of the short listed Bidders shall be evaluated for deciding the lowest tenderer and the lowest tenderer (L1) shall be decided on the basis of total contract value including all cost elements listed above.
- b) GIPCL reserves the right to accept or overlook or reject any lower rate offered by the Bidder without assigning any reason there for.
- c) The Bidders are required to quote the rates strictly as per the terms and conditions mentioned above. The conditional tender will not be entertained and will be liable to be summarily rejected.
- d) Rate quoted shall remain valid for 90 days from the date of opening of the techno-commercial bid, which shall have to be extended unconditionally for further maximum of period 60 days, as deemed fit by GIPCL.

9.0 Mode of Payment:

Running bill to the extent of 100% shall become payable. The bill so prepared and certified will be submitted for payment to the office of the GM (Mines). The payment of the certified amount of the Running bills shall be due 15 days after submission, by contractor, of running bill completed in all respect after deducting therefrom: -

10.0 Escalation:

16.0 Foreclosure of Contract in full or in Part:

17.0 Cancellation of LOI and termination of Contract:

However, GIPCL reserves right to extend this period of 7 days, if the circumstances causing delay are found genuine & convincing.

 - e. Consultant has neglected or failed persistently to observe or perform his obligations under the contract or performs unsatisfactorily
 - f. Consultant is found to have acted in breach or violation of any of the safety norms persistently, applicable labour and other laws in relation to the contract and his obligations therein. Consultant commits a breach of the contractual terms and conditions.
- 2. GIPCL shall give a 15 days' notice period to Consultant to rectify the breach, failing which the contract shall stand terminated on the last date of the notice period without requiring any further notice from GIPCL in that behalf.
- Upon such termination, the outstanding dues of Consultant shall be settled subject to the amounts recoverable by GIPCL under the contract from Consultant.

19.0 FORCE MAJEURE:

The performance of the obligations herein contemplated may be suspended without incurring the penalty in the event of the subsistence of Force Majeure conditions.

If a Force Majeure situation arises, the affected Party shall promptly notify the other Party in writing of such conditions and the performance shall be suspended as per mutual agreement. For the purposes of this clause, 'Force Majeure' means an event beyond the control of the Party and not foreseeable by the Party and shall include events of floods, explosions, riots, wars, hurricane, epidemics, any other Act of God, quarantine restrictions, terrorism, government actions and provided always that such acts result in the impossibility of the further performance of the contract.

20. INDEMNITY:

Consultant shall indemnify and keep harmless GIPCL from and against all actions, proceedings, claims, demands, losses, costs, damages and expenses whatsoever which may be brought against or suffered by GIPCL which it may sustain, pay or incur as a result of or in connection with the performance/purported performance/ non-performance of the contract by Consultant.

In case, in any litigation pertaining to labour employed through Consultant if any direction or order is issued by court at any point of time Consultant shall comply with and implement such direction or order whether passed at the time of award of contract or during the pendency of contract. Further, Consultant shall indemnify the Owner/GIPCL against all consequences arising and affecting GIPCL owing to the compliance of the orders by Consultant.

21.0 GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTIONS:

This Contract and the interpretation of the provisions thereof and the performance thereof shall be governed by the laws of India. Notwithstanding any other court or courts having jurisdiction to decide the question (s) forming the subject matter of the reference if the same had been the subject matter of Suit, any and all actions and proceedings arising out or relative to the contract (including any arbitration in terms thereof) shall lie in the court of competent civil jurisdiction in this behalf at Surat only (where this contract has been signed on behalf of the Management) and only the said court shall have jurisdiction to entertain and try such action (s) and / or proceedings to the exclusion of all the other courts.

22.0 ARBITRATION

All disputes, differences, claims and questions, whatsoever, which may arise either during the continuance of this contract or afterwards between the Supplier and GIPCL, touching the interpretation and / or the execution of any clause of this contract, or any other act, deed or commission / omission by any party or as to any other matter in any way relating to these clauses or right, duties, obligations or liabilities or either party under these clauses shall be referred to a Sole Arbitrator under the provisions of The Arbitration And Conciliation (Amendment) Act, 2019 or any statutory modification thereto or reenactment thereof in force from time to time. The seat and venue of such arbitration shall be Surat, Gujarat state only. The arbitration shall be conducted in English language.
